ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Shrimathi Devkunvar Nanalal Bhatt Vaishnav College for Women was started in 1968 with the generous donation of 10 acres of land by our late Founder Chairman Shri Nanalal Bhatt along with 6 lakh rupees donated by Cork industries charity trust. This college was the first women's college in the Kancheepuram district, Tamilnadu. It was granted autonomous status in 2006. The college was re-accredited with 'A+' grade by NAAC in January 2017 and extension of autonomy was granted till 2023. It delivers a high standard of education and discipline through committed staff that makes students wiser and stronger.
