INVITE FOR MINOR RESEARCH PROJECT PROPOSAL 2024-2025

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Last date for submission of proposal along with budget is 15th September 2024.
- 2. The duration of the project is from 1st October 2024 to 15th October 2025.
- 3. Interdisciplinary projects can be undertaken.
- 4. Staff must submit their progress every 3 months to the research cell in the prescribed format. Date, Time and Venue for the presentation will be intimated.
- 5. Staff must complete their project by mid of October 2025 with documentation and statement of expenditure.
- 6. Proposal format is available on our college website which can be downloaded.

Research Dean & Principal (i/c)

Guidelines:

- 1. Staff project will be eligible for a maximum grant of Rs.1,00,000/-.
- 2. Who can apply
 - a. Staff of SDNBVC
 - b. Staff can combine with other department staff
 - c. Staff along with their research scholars
 - d. Maximum of three project members per project are allowed.
- 3. It may be noted that the project proposal should be original, innovative and novel.
- 4. Social relevance projects will be given more priority.
- 5. The project proposals can be submitted to the Research Cell on or before 15th September 2024.
- 6. Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts and those selected will be announced.
- 7. The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report should be submitted by mid of October 2025.
- 8. The progress report of the sanctioned project must be submitted every six months once.
- Minimum requirement of two publications is required for completion of the Minor Research project
 - One publication in Scopus indexed/Web of Science
 - One publication in any of our college research journals (IJMRASC, SIJTRD)
- 10. The Utilization Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SE) should be signed by the team members and submitted to the Dean of Research.
- 11. The project team should not change the topic and should not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal.

General Instructions for Interdisciplinary Projects

- 1. Interdisciplinary projects will be more preferable.
- 2. Staff should give the undertaking for presentation, publications and patent.
