### INVITE FOR YOUNG RESEARCHER PROJECT PROPOSAL 2024-2025

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Last date for submission of proposal along with budget is 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024.
2. The duration of the project is from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 to 15<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
3. Students' Project can be carried over as a group project
  - Maximum of 4 students in a project is allowed.
  - A staff from the respective department must be the supervisor for the project.
  - It is the responsibility of the staff to see to it that the students complete the project in time and submit the thesis on time.
4. The students are requested to submit a monthly progress report to the research cell in the prescribed format duly signed by the guide.
5. The Students are requested to present their progress as a presentation after 2 months to the research cell. Date, Time and Venue for the presentation will be intimated.
6. The students are expected to complete their project by the mid of March 2025 with documentation and Statement of expenditure.
7. The final presentation will be scheduled in the last week of March 2025.
8. Interdisciplinary projects can be undertaken.

### **General Instructions**

1. Student projects will be eligible for a maximum grant of Rs.20,000/-.
2. The project team (batch) can have up to a maximum of four students. A team should send only one proposal.
3. It may be noted that the project proposal should be original, innovative and novel.
4. The project proposals can be submitted to the Research Cell on or before 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and also mail the proposal to [researchskillsdnbvc@gmail.com](mailto:researchskillsdnbvc@gmail.com) under the header YRP 2024-Guide Name.
5. They should have utility and applicability for implementation. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project is also based on these factors.
6. The Project Guides / HODs need to evaluate the project proposals and scrutinize them before sending the project proposals to the Research cell.
7. The project team should not change the topic and should not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal.
8. Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts and those selected will be announced on our college website.
9. The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report should be submitted before the end of March 2025.
10. The Statement of Expenditure (SE) should be signed by the guide and submitted to the Research Cell.

### **General Instructions for Interdisciplinary Projects**

1. Interdisciplinary projects will be more preferable.
2. Each department should have a separate guide.
3. Guides and students should give the undertaking for presentation, publications and patent.
